Carol Burnside, age 72, of Rock Cave, died Tuesday, March 29, 2016, at the Charleston Area Medical Center in Kanawha City, WV. Burnside, who preceded her in death on June 26, 2013. 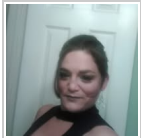
