Curtis D. Rhoades, age 59, of Buckhannon, died Wednesday, November 14, 2018, at his home. He was born January 26, 1959, in Elkton, MD. He was united in marriage on May 1, 1980, to Susan Lee Jones Rhoades who survives. In addition to his wife, he is also survived by one son Eric D. Rhoades and fiancée Katie Groah of Buckhannon; four grandchildren: Rayna, Willow, Godric and Nekaiya; one brother Larry Rhoades of Salem; one sister Marcy Rhoades of Elkton, MD; several aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews and cousins; and father- and mother-in-law Warren and Betty Sargent of French Creek.
