Elmer T. Wimer, age 88, of McChord Run Rd, Walkersville, died Sunday, October 31, 2010, at his home. He was born February 16, 1922, at Redfield, South Dakota, a son of the late Ord and Zamie F. Moore Wimer. He was united in marriage March 29, 1947, to Virginia D. Wilfong Wimer, who preceded him in death on March 23, 2003. He is survived by two daughters; Katheryn D. "Katie" and husband Roscoe Robinson of Walkersville, Virginia "Fern" Watson of Ireland; one grandson, Daniel A. Queen; one granddaughter, Sherry A. Simons; one great grandson, Dakota Thorn Simons all of Ireland; one brother, James M. and wife LouAnne Wimer of Horner, WV; one sister, Glenna M. They also operated Thorndale Farms and were the first owners of Buelingo Cattle in WV. He was a Protestant by Faith.
