Floy Belle "Sis" Burr, age 86, of Buckhannon, died Tuesday, June 1, 2021, at the J.W. Ruby Memorial Hospital in Morgantown. She was born on June 14, 1934, in Upshur County, a daughter of the late John Roosevelt and Zeta Viola Loudin Hurst.
