



James Vernon "Jimmy" Beavers

James Vernon "Jimmy" Beavers, age 60, of Buckhannon, died Thursday, February 10, 2022, at the United Hospital Center in Bridgeport. He was born in Richwood, WV on April 29, 1961, a son of the late Vernon Denzil and Virginia Ann Amick Beavers. In addition to his parents, he was also preceded in death by his stepmother Katherine Beavers; one brother Edward Beavers; and one sister Denise K. Moul. He is survived by two sisters: Betty Ann Beavers, address unknown, and Catherine Sue Vandall and husband Mark of Rainelle; three aunts: Mary Vance and husband Jeff of Richwood, Bonnie Bess of Richwood, and Dreama Salinas and husband Raul of Universal City, TX; several nieces, nephews, and cousins; and countless friends and neighbors.
