Jim worked hard all his life to enjoy the life the Lord blessed him with. He was a proud child of God, loving the Lord with all his heart. He attended the Rock Cave Baptist Church with Pastor David Jessie, whom he loved very much. His church family and many special friends held special places in his heart. When he passed away, he was at total peace knowing he was going to Heaven to meet his Lord and Savior along with loved ones that had already went on ahead of him. We are sure he is in Heaven jumping for joy. His favorite Bible verse was Psalm 23, and he said the Lord's Prayer every night. He always had a smile on his face and enjoyed fellowshiping with everyone he met.
