Junior Lee Cobb, age 69, of French Creek, died Tuesday, November 1, 2016, at St. Joseph's Hospital in Buckhannon. He was born March 24, 1947, in Upshur County, a son of the late Lawrence and Bertha Collins Cobb. He was united in marriage on June 9, 1972, to Karen J. Osburn Cobb, who survives.
