Lloyd "Ray" Ogden, 83, of Rock Cave, died January 11, 2024, at Bridgeport Healthcare Center. He was born May 5, 1940, in Upshur County, a son of the late Elvin Curley and Ruby Mae (Lee) Ogden. On May 13, 1989, he was united in marriage to Myrtle Louise Wilfong Cutright Ogden, who preceded him in death on April 15, 2021.
