November 27, 1921 - August 19, 2018

Mavedell Reger, age 96, of Charlotte, NC, and formerly of Upshur County, went home to be with her Lord and Savior on Sunday, August 19, 2018, at Novant Matthews Medical Center in Hospice Care. She was born November 27, 1921, in Alexander, WV, a daughter of the late Esley Hanson and Burla Simons Bennett. She was united in marriage to her sweetheart, Ernie Reger, on June 14, 1941, who preceded her in death on January 19, 1998. She is survived by one daughter Charlotte R. Moon and husband Rod of Charlotte, NC; one son Randy Reger of Buckhannon; two granddaughters Stasha Kucel and husband Joel of Prosper, TX and Marcy Turner and husband Adam of Raleigh, NC; two grandsons Jeremy Reger and wife Jayme of Marion, OH and Jared Moon of Charlotte, NC; three great granddaughters Brooke Kucel, Julianne Reger, and Josephine Reger; and five great grandsons Cameron Kucel, Dillon Kucel, Jordan Reger, Jude Turner, and Isaac Turner.
