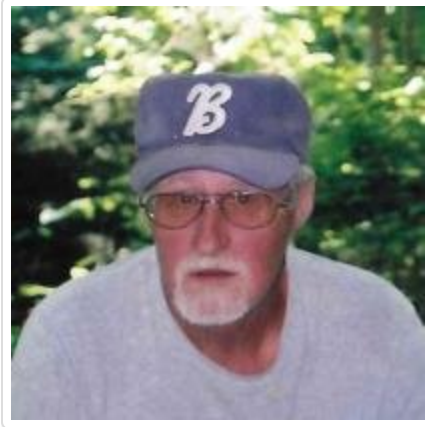




Ralph Robert "Bob" Kelley

Ralph Robert "Bob" Kelley, "Peabody," age 66, of Camden Avenue, Buckhannon, died Saturday, January 21, 2017, at his home.
