Ronald P. Elmore, age 77, of Jolynne Drive, Buckhannon, died Tuesday, August 28, 2018, at the United Hospital Center in Bridgeport. He was born on April 14, 1941, in Spencer, WV, a son of the late Clarence D. and Norma V. Rogers Elmore. On May 25, 1962, he was united in marriage to Barbara L. Fouty Elmore, who survives. Also surviving are one sister Suetta Brockleman of Bridgeport; numerous nieces, nephews, and cousins; and his beloved cat, "Tabby, No!"

Ron was a retired 20-year veteran of the United States Air Force. Upon returning to West Virginia, he was employed by Bill Kelley Motors as a Parts Manager, and later Napa Auto Parts in Buckhannon. He was a devout Catholic, and parishioner of the Holy Rosary Catholic Church in Buckhannon. Ron was a 4th degree Knight of Columbus and Past Grand Knight of the Elkins Council #603 and Past Faithful Navigator of Our Lady of the Mountains Assembly #3159. He loved to hunt, fish, and visit with all those he knew and met.

The family will receive friends at the Heavner and Cutright Funeral Chapel on Thursday, August 30, 2018, from 5-8:00 PM, with a prayer service beginning at 7:30 PM.
