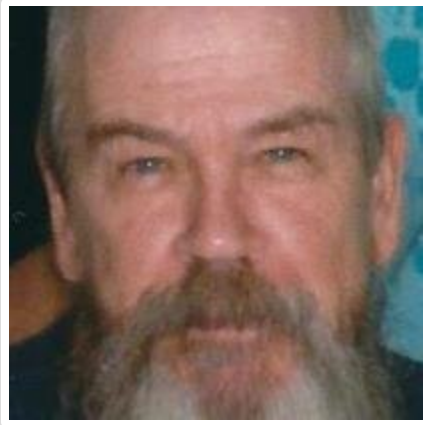




Thomas P. "Tommy" Albaugh

Thomas P. "Tommy" Albaugh, age 65, of Buckhannon died Sunday, September 30, 2018, at his home. He was born June 1, 1953, in Portsmouth, VA a son of the late Col. Cornelius C. "Neil" Albaugh, Jr. and Martha Page Albaugh. He was united in marriage on September 27, 1991, to Mary L. Evans Albaugh who survives. “ I only met Tommy twice and each time was memorable. He was funny, generous, kind and so much fun to hang out with.

The first time I met him was at church for a wedding of his brother to my mother.

He cracked me up during the church services, before the wedding, by interrupting the preacher (after one or two treacherous songs we all tried to sing) to ensure we all sang a song we knew and enjoyed (Silent Night) rather than the lesser known songs we were struggling to get through. I was amused, stunned, and impressed when I heard an interruption of the preacher. I turned around saw this man (I had yet to meet) with his leg up in the air and his hymn song book in one hand and the other hand lifted to the crowd encouraging everyone to join him in a song we could all sing. This seemed unheard of to me, it might well be, unless you are Tommy Albaugh. What a character, but he was right we did need an easier song. I suppose when your grandfather builds the church, and your brother is getting married that day, you have influence or maybe simply because you're Tommy Albaugh you have influence....after all we all joined him in song.

The other time I met him, he was once again, funny, generous, kind and so much fun. I was lucky to spend the day with him, Mary and Erin in D.C. the day before Tommy's father's funeral at Arlington National Cemetery.

Tommy gave us great a tour, knowing where to go, the history behind every monument, or museum we saw. He shared history with a different "angle" than I am use to hearing. The one I recall most quickly was him explaining to us (while we were visiting the Jefferson Memorial) that Thomas Jefferson enjoyed Gothic art. He told us he even had a Gothic ink well he used when signing important documents etc. (if I

recall correctly). Who knows these things, Tommy Albaugh, that's who, or he was pulling my leg, I don't know, I loved it either way.

I am glad I got to spend some time with him, even if only a few times. I will miss him, so I can't imagine how much those who were closer to him will miss him.

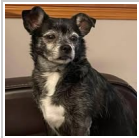
