Velva C. Malcolm Austin, age 86, of French Creek, went home to be with the Lord and join her many family and friends on Wednesday, August 13, 2014, at the Crestview Manor Nursing Facility in Jane Lew. She was born on November 13, 1927, in Lewis County, a daughter of the late Alva W. and Lenora Heavner Malcolm. She was united in marriage to Carroll Austin in 1957, who preceded her in death in 1974.
