Virgil Blaine "Bub" White, of Buckhannon, died Tuesday, December 11, 2007 at the young age of 70. Virgil completed his journey to everlasting life after a long courageous battle with cancer. He was born December 18, 1936 at Buckhannon, a son of the late James H. and Ruth Norman White. He is survived by his wife Nancy D. Haddix White.
